The dishes were judged by: co-owner of Lilia and Misi NYC, Chef Missy Robbins, co-founder and co-CEO of Sweetgreen Inc. Nicolas Jammet, former Food + Wine editor- in-chief Dana Cowin, and Cornell University Cooperative Extension associate, founder of the Cornell Hydroponics, Aquaculture and Aquaponics Learning Labs, Dr. Philson Warner. After much deliberation, Team Chancellor David Banks was announced as the winning team for their delicious pesto pasta dish!

Through their partnership with Goldman Sachs and the Food Education Fund, Food and Finance HS will receive \$300,000 in scholarship money and \$300,000 to fund their "Game Changer" program, which will allow their students to earn their Associates degree, debt free, in one year while participating in a paid internship program. Erika Hurtado is currently working with CUNYs academic department to tailor and align their Hospitality & Culinary program with their HS Curriculum to create a rigorous college and career readiness experience for their students, resulting in the accumulation of 30 college credits by the time they graduate high school.
